CULTURE AND HISTORY



EL MORRO & MORE: WALKING TOUR (Code: SJU29)

Old San Juan's streets, located on a peninsula jutting into the Caribbean Sea, are perfect for exploring on foot - something this tour gives you ample opportunity to do. Escorted by your guide, followed by a photo stop and water break at the Rogativa monument in honour of Puerto Rican women who stymied a British invasion in 1797. The spot also affords great views of San Juan Bay, the nearby 16th-century Fortaleza and the governor's private residence. After, we will continue our journey to Fort San Felipe del Morro, or simply El Morro, perched on the tip of the promontory. Built in the 16th century, the imposing fortress features six different lines of defence, including a water battery tower and casemate guns. After a look around, you'll move on to the adjoining Ballajá Barracks area and then the totem dedicated to the indigenous Taíno people at the Plaza del Quinto Centenario. Right next door you'll find San José Square and its white-fronted church, a jewel of Spanish Gothic architecture completed in 1735. You'll also see many French- and Spanish-inspired buildings from various eras, so keep your camera at hand. The last visit on your walk will then be the mid-18th-century Chapel of Christ the Saviour before your return to the ship.

Please note: The price of the tour includes admission to the San Felipe del Morro Fort. Guests are advised to ask for and keep the receipt at the Fort of San Felipe del Morro as proof of purchase. Daily fort opening times are between 09:00 to 16:30 hours. This is a walking tour and includes walk over uneven terrain, some uphill and cobblestone streets with some stairs. Guests will walk approximately 3.2 miles.

Board a bus and enjoy a short guided sightseeing drive through the Old and New town with an opportunity to see some historic landmarks, such as the Capitol Building while en route to your show destination. You will then stop at a restaurant in the heart of the city for a complimentary drink and a folklore show. In consideration of Puerto Rico rich history, the local folklore has been influenced by the most vibrant rhythms from Africa to the fieriest expressions of Flamenco from Spain. With this in mind, this show will take you on a journey where you can experience a variety of dances and sounds originating from Cuba, Brazil and Dominican Republic. You will get to enjoy popular rhythms like the Mambo, Samba, Merengue, Plena, Salsa and Flamenco. Latin Fiesta has all you expect to see in the beautiful island of Puerto Rico. Be a part of the show, embrace the experience, and enjoy the magic of Latin America's folklore.

Please note: This tour is suitable for all ages. Participants must be 18 years old, to sample alcoholic beverages. Wear comfortable shoes and clothing. Order of stops may vary depending on traffic and local conditions. Traffic in Old and New San Juan could get congested and rerouting may be encountered. Guests with difficulty walking are welcomed however there are some steps to climb at the show.

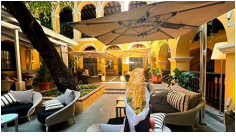

SOMETHING SPECIAL



SAVOR SAN JUAN'S CULINARY DELIGHTS (Code: SJU42)

Experience a slice of Puerto Rican paradise through this guided food and culture walking tour of Old San Juan, where you will stop at five destinations along the route of the fortified colonial city to taste local cuisine and drinks. Leaving the port, you will pass Plaza Darsenas, uphill to Calle del Cristo through the historic center, where you will pass the Catedral de San Juan Bautista, before arriving at the historic El Convento Hotel, a former convent turned boutique hotel. Here, in El Convento's interior courtyard, you will try a refreshing cocktail and traditional Puerto Rican fritter. Next, you will wind through Plaza de Armas, past City Hall, as you make your way toward Chocobar Cortés, a chocolatier that has been run by the Cortés family for four generations, since 1929. Taste the chocolatier's specialty of dark chocolate squares on cheddar cheese, and Puerto Rican coffee infused with chocolate. Digesting this, you will head upstairs to explore exhibits in the family's art gallery run by its nonprofit Fundación Casa Cortés, whose mission promotes Caribbean art and culture in the region through education. The foundation's post-Hurricane Maria efforts, which turned its gallery into a school for 105 local children and teachers for three months following the devastation, have been heralded throughout Puerto Rico. Leaving Calle San Francisco, you will head to Lounge Cultura, a private 19th-century three-story home turned culinary school on Calle Tanca. Here, you will participate in a hands-on experience making "mofongo" with cassava and stewed chicken using a mortar and pestle and learn to shake a traditional Puerto Rican passion cocktail and a delicious cheese and guava puff pastry. With more than 80% of the world's rum coming from Puerto Rico, no tour would be complete without a piña colada, the national drink of Puerto Rico that originated in San Juan. On this note, you will end the tour with a quick stop for dessert at Señor Paleta, where you will enjoy a refreshing artisanal gelato or sorbet paleta, before heading to a unique local bar. Here, you will get a history tour and a lesson on Puerto Rican rum, including Don Q and Barrilito, and learn how to make the fruity cocktail. As this last stop is near the port, guests can either be guided back to the ship or linger longer on their own in beautiful Old San Juan. Please note: Guests must be at least 18 years old to consume alcohol. Please wear comfortable, sturdy walking shoes adept for cobblestone streets. The Fundación Casa Cortés Gallery and Lounge Cultura are on the 2nd floor, up a flight of stairs. Please advise of any food allergies. Menu and venues are subject to change.

You will be welcomed by staff at a local restaurant with unique Puerto Rican hors d'oeuvres and their renowned chef will demonstrate how to create the famous cassava mofongo. The mofongo it is a must-try for first-time visitors who want to claim to have sampled the local fare. Become a chef for a day and find out how this incredible Puerto Rican meal is made, then, at the end, enjoy the fruits of your own delicious creation!

Explore two of the most popular places on the island, the Historic Old San Juan, and "El Yunque" Rainforest. In the Old City, you will pass by many historical landmarks, such as the Capitol Building, and other displays of the 17th century architecture. You will have a chance to visit the San Cristobal Fortress, the largest fortification built by the Spanish in the New World. Travelling from the Old City, you will pass by New San Juan with panoramic views of the Condado District. You'll then make your way to visit the only tropical rainforest in the United States National Forest System. This national treasure exhibits jungle-like vegetation, small horsetail waterfalls, and the cool fresh air. Stop briefly at one of the waterfalls and at the historical "Yokahu" tower to have a panoramic view of this tropical woodland and the unique flora. Enjoy the experience of this captivating ecosystem before returning to your ship.

Please note: It is recommended that guests wear comfortable shoes, clothing, and bring a light raincoat. The order of stops may vary. Traffic may become congested, and re-routing may occur. Guests may be required to walk on uneven grounds at the rainforest. Commercial use of photos or videos is not permitted.

Discover Puerto Rico's rich history and architectural heritage on a guided walking tour of the oldest section of colonial Old San Juan, dating back 500 years. Stroll through cobblestone streets, lined with tropical-hued buildings, and across San Juan Gate as your guide introduces you to the key sights and monuments. You will walk through La Princesa Boulevard, San Juan Gate, the San Felipe del Morro grounds, Ballaja Sector, and down Calle Cristo to end at la Capilla del Cristo. After that, you can choose to stay at la Calle Fortaleza and Cristo's for some shopping on your own or be escorted by your tour guide back to the ship.

Please note: it is recommended that guests wear comfortable walking shoes and bring sunscreen. This tour consists of a considerable amount of walking. Guests may be required to walk on uneven terrain and uphill. Guests will walk approximately 2.8 miles.

You'll have photo opportunities at the Capitol Building, the Palace of the Laws (outside only), and Fort San Cristobal (outside only), the largest Spanish fortification in the Americas, located in the Old City. 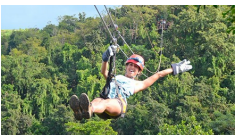
